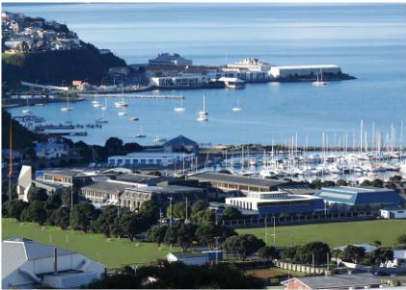


St Patrick's College – Wellington
